Competency-based methodology was pioneered by Hay-McBer company founder David McClelland, a Harvard University psychologist in the late 1960's and early 1970's (Czarnecki, 1995) McClelland set out to define competency variables that could be used in predicting job performance and that were not biased by race, gender, or socioeconomic factors
